




MONTHLY REPORT


FINANCIAL & GRANTS

- Completing the final report for the \$350,000.00 GOCO grant the district receive back in 2011 for the completion of the school ball field.


SEPTEMBER MONTHLY SALES REPORT






ANNUAL COMPARISONS
