- Employee Handbook is being thoroughly reviewed and revised prior to a legal review.


Financial & GRANTS







ISSUES + CONCERNS

Maintenance & Repairs

- Roof leak
 - Cannot apply spray foam insulation in the winter unless temp is above 60 degrees (see picture below)
